WHEREAS, this Warranty Deed is in conjunction with the York Street Capital Improvement Program Project – York Street from 78<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue, for a portion of 8760 Devonshire Blvd, located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 68 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, County of Adams, State of Colorado.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Adams County Planning Commission recommends to the Board of County Commissioners that said Warranty Deed from Devonshire Auto Wash, LLC be accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.
