RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Board of County Commissioners Approves the Agreement Regarding Major Drainageway Planning for and Flood Hazard Area Delineation for Second Creek

BACKGROUND:

This Agreement is with the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District (District), City of Commerce City (Commerce City), City of Aurora (Aurora), City and County of Denver (Denver) and City of Brighton (Brighton) regarding the major drainageway planning and flood hazard area delineation of Second Creek within Adams County (County).

The County, the District, Commerce City, Aurora, Denver and Brighton (Sponsors) wish to proceed with development of a drainageway master plan and a flood hazard area delineation report for Second Creek (Project). This Agreement will commit the County to funding in the amount of \$20,000 to the project. The District will contribute \$100,000, Commerce City will contribute \$35,000, Aurora will contribute \$30,000, Denver will contribute \$20,000 and Brighton will contribute \$10,000 to the Project.

The Second Creek drainage basin was previously studied in conjunction with other adjacent drainage basins. The County, the District, Commerce, Brighton, Aurora, and City and County of Denver participated in a joint planning study titled, "Second Creek, Third Creek, DFA 0053 & Barr Lake Drainage Basin Planning," by Kiowa Engineering Corporation, dated November 1988; and the District and the Colorado Water Conservation Board participated in a joint planning study titled, "Flood Hazard Area Delineation, Second Creek & Third Creek," by Gingery Associates Inc., dated February 1976. The Sponsors wish to update these outdated studies specifically for Second Creek.
