RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN ADAMS COUNTY AND SIGNAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH NETWORK FUNDED THROUGH THE 2016/2017 CORE SERVICES PLAN FOR THE ADAMS COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT, CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES DIVISION

WHEREAS, Signal Behavioral Health Network currently provides substance abuse services to families referred to and by the Adams County Human Services Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Signal Behavioral Health Network program is funded through the Core Services Plan budget; and,

WHEREAS, the Core Services Plan provides one hundred percent of the Signal Behavioral Health Network program funding in the amount of \$125,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Human Services Department is pleased with services provided by Signal Behavioral Health Network, believes the fees are reasonable, and wishes to award an agreement to Signal Behavioral Health Network by means of the attached Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado that the award be made to Signal Behavioral Health Network to provide substance abuse services to families referred to and by the Adams County Human Services Department Children and Family Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair is hereby authorized to sign the agreement with Signal Behavioral Health Network after negotiation and approval as to form is completed by the County Attorney's Office.
