### **BACKGROUND:**

Resolution 2014-182 to continue the Community Corrections Board (CCB) and the Community Corrections By-laws designate the composition of the membership of the Community Corrections Board. The CCB is comprised of eleven board members with six of the eleven members representing specific stakeholder agencies. All appointments are for 3-year terms. The remaining five positions are considered to be “at-large” positions and include two representatives from the City and County of Broomfield per the IGA with Broomfield to provide community corrections services to the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District.

There is currently one vacancy and six members whose terms that will expire on 01/31/17. All of the members have expressed an interest to serve and the Community Corrections Board is recommending all of the appointments.

- Dave Young, District Attorney, has requested that Patrick Costigan fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Timothy McCormack as the representative for the District Attorney’s office.

Recommended re-appointments are:

- Honorable Patrick T. Murphy- serving as the position of a District or County Court Judge;

- Shannon Carson, Deputy Public Defender, serving as the representative for the Public Defender's Office;
- Jenifer Morgen, Chief Probation Officer, serving as the representative from the Probation Department;
- Debbie Stutzman, representing an at large position;
- Margaret Summers, representing an at large position;
- Abigail Tucker, Director of Community Reach Center, representing an at large position.
