BACKGROUND:

Every year in January, Risk Management meets with our Insurance Broker to develop a market strategy for the renewal of expiring county wide insurance policies which expire on April 30. At that time insurance market conditions are reviewed. The County Insurance Program is designed to have the type and amount of coverage to best protect the County's financial assets. The insurance policy period is one year. Expiring insurance policies are marketed to appropriate insurance carriers to obtain competitive quotations. Once the quotations are received, they are reviewed by our insurance Broker, County Manager and Risk Management. The results are then presented to the BoCC.
