RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
ADAMS COUNTY AND BOULDER COUNTY TO CONDUCT BRT STATION DESIGN  
AND IDENTIFY MULTIMODAL CONNECTIVITY AND RIGHT-OF-WAY NEEDS ON  
STATE HIGHWAY 7

WHEREAS, Adams County (County) and Boulder County (Boulder), recently completed a Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Feasibility Study along State Highway 7 (SH 7); and,

WHEREAS, based on the successful outcome of the Feasibility Study, the County and Boulder wish to further study transit stations, right-of-way needs and multimodal connections to station areas along State SH7 (the Study); and,

WHEREAS, Boulder received \$160,000 through the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) to conduct the Study; and,

WHEREAS, the County, the City and County of Broomfield and City of Thornton have agreed to provide local match contributions towards the Study; and,

WHEREAS, executing the attached Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Boulder will authorize Adams County to pay its local match of \$13,000 in 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the Intergovernmental Agreement between Adams County and Boulder County to conduct a transit study on State Highway 7, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, be approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to execute said IGA on behalf of Adams County after the IGA has been reviewed and approved by the County Attorney's Office.
