RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT TWO TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN ADAMS COUNTY AND ALMOST HOME INC., TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY SHELTER AND TRANSITIONAL HOUSING FOR TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF)

WHEREAS, Almost Home Inc., is currently providing emergency shelter, case management and referrals, education and advocacy, and transitional housing services for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) in Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, this Human Service Department program is being funded eighty-five (85%) by the Federal TANF Block Grant, with Adams County responsible for the remaining fifteen (15%) percent; and,

WHEREAS, Almost Home Inc., agrees to provide the services for a total amount of \$130,000.00 for the last year renewal; and,

WHEREAS, the Human Services Department is pleased with services provided by Almost Home Inc., believes the renewal fees are fair and reasonable, and wishes to exercise the last renewal of the existing agreement with Almost Home Inc., by means of the attached Amendment Two.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that Amendment Two to the Agreement between Adams County and Almost Home Inc., for emergency shelter and transitional housing for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) be approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair is hereby authorized to sign Amendment Two with Almost Home Inc., after negotiation and approval as to form is completed by the County Attorney's Office.
