

**RESOLUTION APPROVING RE-OPENING RETIREMENT SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 18.**

WHEREAS, Retirement Special Revenue Fund 18 was established in 1970 to account for the mill levy and collection of general property taxes and make employer contributions to the pension trust fund; and,

WHEREAS, Retirement Plan Fund 18 was closed out at the end of 2006 as employer contributions were made to the Pension Plan from each County fund with employees; and,

WHEREAS, the County wishes to re-open Retirement Special Revenue Fund 18 to account for revenues, expenditures, and financial transactions for Fund 18 to be used to fund eligible Adams County Retirement Plan expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the re-opening of Retirement Special Revenue Fund 18 be approved, effective December 31, 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and the Adams County Treasurer are authorized to re-open Retirement Special Revenue Fund 18 on December 31, 2017, to be used for the purposes stated above effective December 31, 2017.
