WHEREAS, the Adams County Planning Commission has considered the advisability of acceptance by the Board of County Commissioners of a Permanent Drainage Easement from Isabelle Estates, Inc., for drainage purposes on the following described land to wit:

Legal description as set forth in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

WHEREAS, this Permanent Drainage Easement is in conjunction with grading and drainage permit application for the Denver Premium Outlets Project, located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 1 South, Range 68 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, County of Adams, State of Colorado.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Adams County Planning Commission recommends to the Board of County Commissioners that said permanent drainage easement be accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.
