New Brantner Extension Ditch Company (NBEDC) has granted Adams County the right to install 2-16' x 6' concrete box culverts in order to support 2- Utility and Road Way/Bridge Crossings for the fee of \$25,000 including any professional fees incurred by NBEDC with the request and subject to those specific details in the attached agreement.
