RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT FOUR TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN ADAMS  
COUNTY AND DENVER CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTER  
FOR MENTAL HEALTH CONSULTATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, Denver Children's Advocacy Center is currently providing Mental Health Consultation Services for Adams County Human Services Department, Head Start Division; and,

WHEREAS, this Human Services Department program is being funded one-hundred (100%) percent by a Federal Grant from the State; and,

WHEREAS, Denver Children's Advocacy Center agrees to provide the services for a total amount of \$66,000.00 for the last renewal year; and,

WHEREAS, the Human Services Department is pleased with services provided by the Denver Children's Advocacy Center, believes the fees are fair and reasonable, and wishes to exercise the last renewal option of the agreement with Denver Children's Advocacy Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that Amendment Four to the Agreement between Adams County and Denver Children's Advocacy Center for Mental Health Consultation Services be approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair is hereby authorized to sign said Amendment Four after negotiation and approval as to form is completed by the County Attorney's Office.
