RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Board of County Commissioners Adopt the Resolution Regarding the Defense and Indemnification of Justin Moore as a Defendant Pursuant to C.R.S.§ 24-10-101, et seq.				

BACKGROUND:

The Board of County Commissioners formally indemnifies employees and elected officials who are named in civil lawsuits. Justin Moore was named as a defendant in a civil action filed in Las Animas District Court. The lawsuit alleges that the Plaintiff, Justin Rueb, who is an inmate in Colorado Department of Corrections custody, suffered damages as a result of a long standing conspiracy to keep him incarcerated.

The County Attorney's Office has reviewed the facts of this lawsuit and has determined that Justin Moore was acting within the course and scope of his employment with the 17th Judicial District Attorney's Office at all relevant times pertaining to this lawsuit/incident. Therefore, the County Attorney's Office is recommending that Justin Moore be indemnified for any potential damages that might arise out of this litigation.
