RESOLUTION APPROVING MODIFICATION OF THE BRIGHTON PARK DESTINATION PLAYGROUNDS OPEN SPACE SALES TAX GRANT

WHEREAS, Adams County voters approved an Open Space Sales Tax on November 2, 1999, to be used in accordance with Resolution 99-1; and,

WHEREAS, City of Brighton received an Open Space Sales Tax grant for the Brighton Park Destination Playgrounds project on May 2, 2017, for a total of 60% of the total project costs, up to \$363,000; and,

WHEREAS, City of Brighton would like to revise the project budget to include the costs of the Midland Park playground; and,

WHEREAS, City of Brighton determined during the bidding process that they would be able to construct the playgrounds concurrently; and,

WHEREAS, City of Brighton would receive better pricing based on the proximity of both playgrounds; and,

WHEREAS, the grant award would remain the same for 60% of the total project costs, up to \$363,000; and,

WHEREAS, the Open Space Advisory Board voted unanimously in support of the modification on April 24, 2019; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the City of Brighton's Open Space Modification Request for the Brighton Park Destination Playground Open Space Sales Tax Grant is hereby approved.
