RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUITCLAIM DEED CONVEYING PROPERTY FROM
MITCHELL RONALD ESPINOZA TO ADAMS COUNTY,
FOR THE DEDICATION OF ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, Adams County is in the process of acquiring right-of-way for the 2018 Miscellaneous Concrete and ADA Ramps Project along the Broadway Street-Conifer Road corridor from U.S. Highway 36 to 84th Avenue (“Project”); and,

WHEREAS, this right-of-way parcel is from property at 8133 Conifer Road, located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 2 South, Range 68 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, County of Adams, State of Colorado and is owned by Mitchell Ronald Espinoza (“Parcel”); and,

WHEREAS, Adams County requires ownership of the Parcel for construction of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, Mitchell Ronald Espinoza has executed a Quitclaim Deed to dedicate the Parcel for road right-of-way purposes for Conifer Road that complies with County standards and will benefit the citizens of Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Planning Commission for Adams County, Colorado, held at the County Government Center in Brighton on Thursday the 13th day of June, 2019, the Planning Commission recommended that the Board of County Commissioners accept said Quitclaim Deed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the Quitclaim Deed from Mitchell Ronald Espinoza, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, be and hereby is accepted.
