RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUITCLAIM DEED CONVEYING PROPERTY FROM VANDARA PONGPHACHANXAY TO ADAMS COUNTY FOR THE DEDICATION OF ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, Adams County is in the process of acquiring right-of-way for the 2018 Miscellaneous Concrete and ADA Ramps Project along the Broadway Street-Conifer Road corridor from U.S. Highway 36 to 84th Avenue ("Project"); and,

WHEREAS, this right-of-way parcel is from property at 7790 Pecos Street, located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 68 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, County of Adams, State of Colorado and is owned by Vandara Pongphachanxay ("Parcel"); and,

WHEREAS, Adams County requires ownership of the Parcel for construction of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, Vandara Pongphachanxay has executed a Quitclaim Deed to dedicate the Parcel for road right-of-way purposes for Pecos Street that complies with County standards and will benefit the citizens of Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Planning Commission for Adams County, Colorado, held at the County Government Center in Brighton on Thursday the 13th day of February, 2020, the Planning Commission recommended that the Board of County Commissioners accept said Quitclaim Deed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the Quitclaim Deed from Vandara Pongphaxhanxay, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, be and hereby is accepted.
