RESOLUTION APPROVING CONTINUANCE OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT BETWEEN ADAMS COUNTY AND THE MUNICIPAL PARTNERS FOR
THE A-LIFT TRANSIT PROGRAM

WHEAREAS, Adams County, in partnership with the Cities of Arvada, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, and Westminster (the “municipal partners”) work together with DRCOG to coordinate the A-Lift Transit Program (“A-Lift Program”), a transit service for seniors and residents with special needs in Adams County; and

WHEAREAS, the municipal partners have continued to provide support and leadership for the A-Lift Program through the Policy Council for the past thirty years; and

WHEAREAS, the municipal partners have provided a collective \$200,000 contribution towards the A-Lift Program yearly since 2017; and

WHEAREAS, the A-Lift Program continues to provide service to seniors and residents with special needs in Adams County; and

WHEAREAS, the current intergovernmental agreements, entered into in 2017, reflect ongoing and historical successful collaboration of the municipal partners; and

WHEAREAS, ongoing collaboration for the A-Lift Program is set to continue for the foreseeable future for our shared community through the Policy Council; and

WEAREAS, due to a clerical error, Adams County needs to update the Intergovernmental Agreements from 2017 between Adams County and the municipal partners by providing signatures to those agreements to ensure the historical and future work of the A-Lift Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that Adams County will acknowledge and sign the Intergovernmental Agreements from 2017 between the municipal partners and Adams County for the A-Lift Program to continue providing transportation services for Adams County residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to sign said Intergovernmental Agreements from 2017 between Adams County and the municipal partners on behalf of Adams County.
