### **BACKGROUND:**

Adams County has received Community Services Block Grant funds to ameliorate the effects of poverty in local communities from the State Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) since 1974. On September 22, 2020, the Community Action Plan and 2021 budget was approved, which included \$306,000 to be allocated to sub-grantees. Community Services Block Grant Advisory Council respectfully recommends funding Access Housing for \$100,000.

The recommendation is to approve the 2020 Agreement with Access Housing.
