RESOLUTION APPROVING RIGHT-OF-WAY AGREEMENT
BETWEEN ADAMS COUNTY AND ANDREW MILLER
FOR PROPERTY NECESSARY FOR
THE MISCELLANEOUS CONCRETE AND ADA RAMPS PROJECT

WHEREAS, Adams County is in the process of acquiring right-of-way along Broadway Street-Conifer Road corridor from U.S. Highway 36 to 84th Avenue for the Miscellaneous Concrete and ADA Ramps Project (“Project”); and,

WHEREAS, the intention of this Project is to identify and improve the overall mobility and accessibility of maturing neighborhoods with ADA accessibility connectivity including ADA-compliant sidewalks and the addition of ADA pedestrian ramps (“Improvements”) where absent; and,

WHEREAS, this right-of-way acquisition is a portion of 7627 Bannock Street located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 2 South, Range 68 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, County of Adams, State of Colorado, and owned by Andrew Miller, (“Parcel 17”); and,

WHEREAS, Adams County requires ownership of Parcel 17 for construction of the Improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Andrew Miller is willing to sell Parcel 17 to Adams County under the terms and conditions of the attached Right-of-Way Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the attached Right-of-Way Agreement between Adams County and Andrew Miller, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, be and hereby is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to execute said Right-of-Way Agreement on behalf of Adams County.
